RHAN 1

1. As with all Past Tense questions, the Yes / No replies to direct Past Tense questions are always

Do	-	Yes
Naddo	-	No

Fuest ti yn Nantes? - Do.

- Were you / Have you been / Did you go to Nantes? - Yes.

Fuon nhw yng ngwlad Belg? - Do.

- Were they / Did they go to / Have they been in Belgium? - Yes.

Fuodd y plant yn nofio? - Naddo.

- Did the children swim? - No.

Fuoch chi'n dringo? - Naddo.

- Were you / Did you climb(ing)? - No.

Fuest ti yn yr Eidal yn ddiweddar? - Do, fis yn ôl.

- Were you / Did you go to / Have you been in Italy recently? - Yes, a month ago.

Fuodd Basil yn America? - Do.

- Did Basil go / Was Basil / Has Basil been in America? - Yes.

Fuoch chi'n crwydro o gwmpas? - Naddo.

- Did you tour / Were you touring? - No.

2. When 'yn' is merely a linking word with no translatable value, it is often abbreviated to 'n after a vowel

Mae'n oer.

Fuoch chi'n nofio?

Roedd hi'n denau.

But if 'yn' conveys the preposition 'in' then it is NEVER abbreviated, even after a vowel.

Fuoch chi yn yr Eidal?

Fe fuon ni yn Ffrainc y llynedd.

It sometimes changes its form to 'ym' or 'yng' of course

Fe fuon ni ym Mangor.

Fuoch chi yng Nghaernarfon?

RHAN 2

1. The negative forms pose no problems - as with other Past Tense verbs, drop the 'Mi / Fe' and add 'ddim'

Fe / Mi fues i yn yr Almaen.
Fues i **ddim** yn yr Almaen.

Fe / Mi fuon nhw'n barcuta.
Fuon nhw **ddim** yn barcuta.

Fues i ddim dramor eleni.
- **I didn't go / haven't been** abroad this year.

Fuon ni ddim ar y Cyfandir.
- **We didn't go / haven't been** on the Continent.

Fuodd y plant ddim yn Disney World.
- **The children didn't go / haven't been** in Disney World.

2. And we can add another verb to the 'bues' forms to express the Past Tense.

Fuon ni ddim **yn nofio** yn y môr.
- We didn't **swim** in the sea.

Fuon nhw ddim **yn brigdonna**.
- They didn't **surf**.

Fuodd y plant ddim **yn barcuta**.
- The children didn't **hang glide**.

Fues i ddim **yn segura** - fe fues i'n brysur iawn.
- I didn't **idle (take it easy)** - I was very busy.

3. Other question words are familiar to you

Gyda phwy buest ti'n merlota? - Gyda'r plant.
- **With whom** did you go / were you pony trekking? - With the children.
Gyda phwy buodd y plant yn chwarae?
- **With whom** did the children play?

Pryd buon nhw ar eu gwyliau? - Ym mis Awst.
- **When** did they go / were they on holiday? - In August.

Pryd buest ti'n brigdonna ddiwetha'?
- **When** did you surf (go surfing) last?
