RHAN 1

1. The first person plural ('us')

us - ein + verb + ni

Wyt ti'n **ein deall ni**?
- Do you **understand us**?

Fydd hi ddim yn **ein beio ni**.
- She won't be **blaming us**.

2. The second person plural (and singular 'polite') ('you')

you - eich + verb + chi

Fe fydda' i'n **eich talu chi** yfory.
- I'll be **paying you** tomorrow.

Ydyn nhw wedi **eich clywed chi**?
- Have they **heard you**?

3. The third person plural ('them')

them - eu + verb + nhw

Rydw i wedi **eu colli nhw**.
- I have **lost them**.

Mae hi'n **eu hoffi nhw**.
- She **likes them**.

4. There is no mutation at all after

ein eich eu

RHAN 2

1. A round up of all the persons

Er enghraifft - For example - 'talw'

Mae John wedi **fy nhalu i**.
- John has **paid me**.

Mae John wedi **dy dalu di**.
- John has **paid you**.

Mae John wedi **ei dalu fe (fo)**.
- John has **paid him**.

Mae John wedi **ei thalu hi**.
- John has **paid her**.

Mae John wedi **ein talu ni**.
- John has **paid us**.

Mae John wedi **eich talu chi**.
- John has **paid you**.

Mae John wedi **eu talu nhw.**
- John has **paid them.**

2. Because 'wedi' ends in a vowel, it's possible to abbreviate

wedi ei	>	wedi'i
wedi ein	>	wedi'n
wedi eich	>	wedich
wedi eu	>	wedi'u

Mae John **wedi'i** dalu fe (fo).
- John has paid him.

Mae John **wedi'i** thalu hi.
- John has paid her.

Mae John **wedi'n** talu ni.
- John has paid us.

Mae John **wedi'ch** talu chi.
- John has paid you.

Mae John **wedi'u** talu nhw.
- John has paid them.
