It's quarter to eight.

ED: Chwarter i wyth?
Quarter to eight?

SIÂN: Ie, chwarter i wyth. Amser codi.
Yes, quarter to eight. Time to get up.

ED: O. Dim eto.
Oh. Not yet.

SIÂN: Iawn. Dim eto.
Right. Not yet.

Ed! Mae hi'n wyth o'r gloch!
Ed! It's eight o'clock!

ED: Faint?
What time?

SIÂN: Mae hi'n wyth o'r gloch! Coda, Ed!
It's eight o'clock! Get up, Ed!

ED: Dim eto. Pum munud arall.
Not yet. Another five minutes.

SIÂN: Na, mae hi'n amser codi rwan.
No, it's time to get up now.
